

LESSON REVIEW ANSWERS

1. According to Hosea 4:6, what destroys people and how does it relate to healing?

Hosea 4:6 states that God's people are destroyed for a lack of knowledge. A lack of knowledge about God's love and His will to heal all keeps many people from receiving healing.

2. How would you respond to someone who tells you Paul's thorn in the flesh was a sickness that God put on him?

Possible answer: Paul's thorn was a messenger sent from Satan to buffet, or to weaken him. In the Old Testament, a thorn in the flesh is associated with persecution and affliction. Paul then says that he boasts in his infirmities, which can mean human weaknesses. He never mentioned sickness in 2 Corinthians 11:23–33 when he listed all of his infirmities.

3. What lesson about our physical well-being can we learn from Timothy?

Possible answers: We need to be wise about the foods and drinks we consume; when there is a healthy alternative, we should take it and not tempt God's divine protection on us.

4. What lessons can we learn about Paul leaving Trophimus in Miletus?

Possible answers: While everybody doesn't get healed, that doesn't mean God doesn't will to heal everybody; apostles didn't have supernatural power or anointing that guaranteed every single person was healed.

5. What lessons can we learn from Epaphroditus being sick and almost dying?

Possible answers: Ministers can get sick; we have to be careful to not overwork ourselves and become sick from the overwork.

6. What lesson can we learn from Elisha getting sick and dying?

Possible answers: Elisha had a double anointing and saw signs and wonders, but he still got sick; even after he was dead, his bones were still anointed and caused a dead man to come to life; he ministered to the king right up until his death.

7. Do you believe that healing passed away with the last apostle? Why or why not?
