ANSWERS**

1. What does the Word of God say about the power of our words?

**Possible answers: Proverbs 18:21 points out that death and life are in the power of the tongue and we get what we speak; James 3:4 reminds us that a ship is turned by a small rudder, and our tongues are small but powerful.**

2. What does the Parable of the Sower (Mark 4:1-20) teach us about words?

**Possible answers: The enemy knows the power of God's spoken Word and tries to steal it from us; the words we listen to are powerful; we can use our words to rebuke the enemy.**

3. What is the creative power of words?

**Possible answers: God created everything by speaking; Jesus's birth fulfilled the spoken prophecies about Him; we can speak and confess what God says about our health to change our situation.**

4. According to Isaiah 55:11, why should you be responsible for speaking God's Word out of your mouth?

**Possible answers: The spoken words of God coming out of your mouth will bring peace and joy and accomplish the things for which He sent it; when I speak God's Word, it is as powerful to create or destroy as when God speaks them.**

5. What can we learn about our words from Jesus cursing the fig tree (Mark 11:12-14 and Matt. 21:18-22)?

**Possible answers: Jesus used the power of His words to curse the fig tree; Jesus's words immediately released power, but the results weren't seen immediately.**

6. What does Mark 11:23–24 teach about how to speak?

**We can use our words as a command, as bold speech, and as a confession of what Jesus says about the situation.**

7. What do you feel needs to change about how you speak?
