Note: All scriptures used in this lesson are quoted from the *King James Version*.

- I. For you to really walk in healing, you've got to know beyond any shadow of a doubt that it is God's will for you to be well.
- II. The majority of religion today will teach that God can heal or deliver, or that God has the power, but they aren't sure that He wants to use it every single time. You might have been taught:
 - A. God only heals some people.
 - B. God actually wants a person to be sick for them to learn something.
 - C. God actually wills for a person to be sick as a punishment.
 - D. God desires for the person to be in that situation.
- III. Receiving from God is absolutely dependent upon your knowing that you have asked according to his will.

And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us: And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.

1 John 5:14–15 KJV

- A. The same way that you got saved is the same way that you receive everything else from the Lord. It's the same way with healing.
- B. You have to believe.

That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.

Romans 10:9 KJV

C. Most people believe what their experiences tell them more than what the Word of God tells them.

IV. You have to believe you receive when you pray, and then there shall be a future manifestation.

Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

Mark 11:24 KJV

A. Jesus cursed a fig tree (Mark 11:12-14 and 20-21), and the Word says in Matthew 21:19 that the fig tree died immediately, and yet it wasn't visible until the next day.

B. The moment you pray and believe for healing, you've got to believe at that moment that Jesus has healed you, and then there shall be a manifestation.

V. There is a link between the level of your soul's prosperity and the level of your health.

Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.

3 John 2 KJV

VI. Jesus never refused to heal a single person.

A. In Matthew 8:1-3, the leper didn't have the benefit of the New Covenant and the New Testament the way that we have, and so really it was fitting for him to say, *Lord, if you will, you can make me clean*, because it wasn't clearly revealed that this was the will of God.

When he was come down from the mountain, great multitudes followed him. And, behold, there came a leper and worshipped him, saying, Lord, if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean. And Jesus put forth his hand, and touched him, saying, I will; be thou clean. And immediately his leprosy was cleansed.

Matthew 8:1-3 KJV

B. What He's done for another person, He will do for you.

For there is no respect of persons with God.

Romans 2:11 KJV

VII. Jesus represented God the Father perfectly.

God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets, Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds; Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high.

Hebrews 1:1-3 KJV

A. Jesus went about doing good and healing everyone.

How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

Acts 10:38 KJV

B. If you really believe that God gave you your sickness, then it's absolutely inconsistent for you to go to the doctor, to take medication, or to have surgery trying to get out of God's will.

C. In heaven, there is not going to be sickness and disease.

After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.

Matthew 6:9-10 KJV

VIII. God allotted a person to live seventy or eighty years old, but God is not the one who controls death.

The days of our years are threescore years and ten; and if by reason of strength they be fourscore years, yet is their strength labour and sorrow; for it is soon cut off, and we fly away.

Psalms 90:10 KJV

A. The devil is the one who causes death.

The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

John 10:10 KJV

B. If Satan can ever get you to think that God put this sickness on you, then you won't fight against it. You won't resist.

Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

James 4:7 KJV

IX. Jesus became a curse for us and redeemed us from the curse.

Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree.

Galatians 3:13 KJV

A. Sickness is a curse (Deut. 28:15-68).

B. There are blessings that come upon you through Jesus (Deut. 28:1-14).
