1. If God didn't create sickness, how did it start?

Sickness is a result of the choice Adam and Eve made to disobey God. Their sin opened the door to spiritual death and then, physical death.

2. When did sickness first appear in the Bible?

3. Define "covenant."

Possible answer: A covenant is a chosen relationship in which binding promises are made to and by each party.

7. Who were the Old and New Covenants for?

The Old Covenant was for one people, the Israelites, but the New Covenant is for all people.

8. Explain the difference between the Old and New Covenants as it pertains to choices being made.

The Old Covenant was God's response to our choice, and the New Covenant was established for us to respond to God's choice.
