Note: All scriptures used in this lesson are quoted from the *New King James Version*.

- I. There are many ways to receive healing. God always heals, but He doesn't always use the same method. It only takes one key of revelation to unlock a healing door for you.
 - A. Know that healing is the will of God for everyone, every time, all the time.
 - B. You have the power of God, so use it. You've got authority.
 - C. Keep exalting the truth above the facts until the truth prevails.
- II. A key that will help you receive healing is to understand that you're loved. Faith works best when we understand we're loved.

For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision avails anything, but faith working through love.

Galatians 5:6

- A. I said, "Lord, don't let my ignorance stop the healing power of God from manifesting in my baby. This is my baby. I know you healed all those others, but Lord I need your healing power to manifest here in my house."
- B. God loves you. God will meet you where you are. And too many times, what happens—especially where our children are concerned—is we get desperate.
- C. Focus on the Lord, and let Him reveal to you how much He loves and cares for you.
- D. There's nothing you've done in life, no mistake you've made, that's going to keep God's love from extending to you.
- E. God's love is superabundant, and He's not holding out on you. He's not holding back from you.

[That you] *may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height—to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.*

Ephesians 3:18-19

- F. If you love your children, where did you get that love? You got it from your heavenly Father. Your Father gave you the ability to love, and how much more will God's love for His children cause healing to come?

If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask Him!

Matthew 7:11

- G. The doctor said this, and the doctor said that. God's love and His Word is greater than what the doctors say. He loves you.

III. Once you meditate on God's love for you, then you will be able to see yourself well.

- A. Once a different picture than the truth is planted in your heart, it's difficult to believe the Word of God in that area of your life.
- B. Let the Word of God and the Spirit of God erase the picture of you being sick.
- C. We've got to change our focus until we see ourselves well on the inside. We become like whatever we behold.

But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord.

2 Corinthians 3:18

- D. Hear the Word and focus on the Word. It's not just one time that you hear the Word—it's hearing and hearing.

So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Romans 10:17

- E. The attention factor: get your attention off the pain, off the doctor's report, and focus on the Lord so that the picture on the inside will change.

My son, give attention to my words; Incline your ear to my sayings. Do not let them depart from your eyes; Keep them in the midst of your heart; For they are life to those who find them, And health to all their flesh.

Proverbs 4:20-22

- F. Your soul—your mind, will, and emotions—is a magnifier. Whatever your soul magnifies will determine either the releasing or the binding of what God has placed and deposited in your spirit.

And Mary said: “My soul magnifies the Lord, And my spirit has rejoiced in God my Savior.”

Luke 1:46-47

- G. The soul of the Israelite people was much discouraged because they had forgotten the miracles that God did for them. They got their eyes off of God. They got their eyes on the condition of the way. We cannot afford to let the barometer of our soul rise and fall based upon the condition of the way (our path) or the condition of our bodies.

Then they journeyed from Mount Hor by the Way of the Red Sea, to go around the land of Edom; and the soul of the people became very discouraged on the way.

Numbers 21:4

- H. God told Moses to put a fiery serpent on a pole, which was a type of Jesus who was to come, who would take all of our sicknesses and diseases upon Himself on the cross. He said whoever looks, beholds, inspects, and considers that sacrifice of Jesus to come would live. Whoever changes his focus from the condition of the way to the Maker of the way will live.

And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man be lifted up.

John 3:14

- IV. Another principle is dealing with counterattacks. More battles are lost in counterattacks than in any other kind of battle.

- A. Demons can't find rest outside of bodies. Jesus said that there is a demon that calls your body his house. Spirits of infirmity, iniquity, and uncleanness say, "Well, I'm going to return to my house." There's a demon who calls your body his house. Don't give the devil any room.

When an unclean spirit goes out of a man, he goes through dry places, seeking rest, and finds none. Then he says, "I will return to my house from which I came." And when he comes, he finds it empty, swept, and put in order. Then he goes and takes with him seven other spirits more wicked than himself, and they enter and dwell there; and the last state of that man is worse than the first. So shall it also be with this wicked generation.

Matthew 12:43-45

- B. Understanding this truth prepares us for future attacks. We were ready for the counterattack, and you need to be ready as well. Don't be naïve, and don't let your spiritual guard down.
- C. When you're ready for these counterattacks and you run the enemy off with the Word, it puts fear in him about trying to attack you again. He'll think twice about coming to your house to try to steal from you.

But He answered and said, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.'"

Jesus said to him, "It is written again, 'You shall not tempt the Lord your God.'"

Then Jesus said to him, "Away with you, Satan! For it is written, 'You shall worship the Lord your God, and Him only you shall serve.'"

Matthew 4:4, 7, and 10

- D. If you consistently resist the devil with the Word, he will flee.

Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

James 4:7

- E. Some people who are healed through the gifts of the Spirit lose their healing later because they've not taken the time after receiving their healing to get filled with the Word of God.

- F. God laughs at the devil, and the devil doesn't know what to do when you laugh at him. When he comes back to try to take from you, just start laughing at him.

He who sits in the heavens shall laugh; The Lord shall hold them in derision.

_____ Psalms 2:4

- G. Stay in faith. Be ready for the devil's counterattacks, and you won't be defeated by them. Stay in faith in the Word regarding every aspect of your being. Don't doubt your healing when the devil comes cloaked in a pain or another lying symptom of sickness or disease.
