Personalize Barry's Closing Prayer

Father, I thank You that I am born again and have a better covenant because of Jesus. I thank You that I know the Enemy is trying to steal, kill, and destroy. I submit to God's provision and grace. I resist the devil, sickness, cancer, diabetes, and heart disease. I have grace to overcome whatever is going on or trying to get into my body. Your grace is sufficient for me. I can stand up, take my authority in Christ, and begin to command health and healing in my body to the glory of God. Amen.
