

POINTS TO PONDER

- Grace is not a license to sin or do whatever the flesh desires. Grace enables you to say, “God, I thank you for your goodness. And as I stand in the way You see me, Holy Spirit, teach me to say ‘no’ to sin and sickness.”
- When you read the Bible, don’t read it for God or just to check something off your performance list. Read it for yourself because it produces life, brings revelation, and affects your heart and emotions. When that happens, it turns into a wellspring of life that overflows and starts to touch your children, husband, friends, and even strangers.
- Your old identification of being lost is no longer true, because you’ve been found in Christ Jesus. Your spirit now has the fullness of God.
- Nobody can make you see yourself the way God sees you. They can make declarations over you or have words of encouragement or prophecy, but you have to take ownership and say, “This is the real me!”
- When you have a revelation of your identity in Christ, you stop believing all the lies of the devil that say you deserve to be where you are.
- Sickness, death, destruction, and attacks don’t define you when you know who you are. You know your God. You know who is within you, and you see yourself that same way He sees you.
- You’ve got to get to the place where you say, “I don’t care what anyone else says or thinks about me. I am going to declare what God says about me, believe what He believes about me, and see myself the way He sees me.”
- You might need to do some things to take care of your physical temple, but you shouldn’t be doing them because of fear or other people’s opinions of your identity.
- When you observe any behavior in yourself that’s bringing you into poverty, depression, sickness, fear, doubt, and worry, realize that behavior is not who you are in Christ.
- No matter what the enemy throws at you or what the society, economy, and government stacks against you, remember that God is good. He can take it, touch it, and breathe on it. Know that He’s going to make it good.
- You have Jesus—the source of healing and the perfect sacrifice—and His shed blood living inside of you. So, declare, “I am healed!”

- There is no question mark in “If God is for us.” Rewrite this sentence: If God is for us, exclamation point, who can be against us, period.
- When the Enemy starts declaring his lies, or when a symptom comes, rebuke it and say, “No! I’m not getting a cold. I don’t care if it’s flu season. I don’t care if every single member of my classroom, workplace, or even my family is sick. I do not receive it. I see it for what it is—the work of the Enemy—and I rebuke it, because I know who I am in Christ.”
