1. How do you know you are able to minister healing to others? Use scripture to explain your answer.

**Possible answers: 2 Corinthians 3:6—I am an able minister of healing to others; Matthew 10:1—Jesus gave power to heal all manner of sickness and disease; John 14:12—Jesus gave power to do greater works; Mark 16:18—I will lay hands on the sick and they will recover; Matthew 10:8—Jesus said to heal the sick.**

2. What are some reasons why someone might not be healed when you pray for them?

**Possible answers: You can't do it against that person's will; the person you're praying for does need some degree of faith; you can be in an unbelieving atmosphere; sometimes a person is just reaping what they've sown because they've allowed an inroad to Satan.**

3. What are some drawbacks to being healed by someone with a gift of healing?

**If you got healed on someone else's faith and don't have your own faith built up, Satan will come and try to steal that healing from you through doubt and unbelief.**

4. What key to healing is found in Mark 16:17-18?

**Belief causes the signs and wonders to happen.**

5. If someone questions or criticizes you for speaking with power and authority, how would you respond, and what scripture could you stand on?

**Possible answer: Isaiah 45:11 says we can command God. I am not the source of the power, but it is at my command.**

6. Is there a certain spiritual level to attain to be able to minister healing to others? Explain your answer.

**Possible answer: No, as soon as I place my trust in Christ for salvation, He gives me all of His power and authority. God anointed me as a believer. The power is in me to release and minister to others.**
