ANSWERS**

1. What is the correlation between salvation and healing?

Possible answers: I can't earn my salvation, and I can't earn my healing; Jesus died on the cross for my sins and for my sicknesses, so I'm forgiven and healed.

2. What role does faith have?

We receive healing by grace through faith, just like we enter into eternal life by grace through faith.

3. How does Psalms 103:1-4 relate to the grace of God?

Possible answers: David encourages us to remember the benefits of God; God has forgiven our sins and healed us because of what Christ did on the cross.

4. Does God's grace mean you'll never be sick? Why or why not?

Possible answer: No; I'm forgiven and righteous, but because sin exists, so does sickness. I'm not a victim of sickness. Because of the grace of God, I'm fighting sickness from a position of victory.

5. If God brought sickness as a punishment under the Old Covenant, is He bringing sickness on people today? Explain your answer.

Possible answer: God afflicted people because of sin under the Old Covenant. Jesus redeemed us from the curse of the law because He redeemed us from sin (Gal. 3:13-14). Jesus wouldn't be healing all if God was still putting sickness on people—Jesus wouldn't go against what God was doing.

6. What role does sin play in your health?

Possible answers: God isn't going to withhold healing because of sin, but it can open a door for Satan to bring sickness into my life; when we confess our faults to one another, it opens the door for healing in our bodies and relationships.

7. After understanding God's grace, how will you receive your healing?

I receive my healing by grace through faith in what Jesus did.
