1. How does the Bible present imagination?

In most scriptures, imagination is referred to as negative or evil. A positive imagination is what the Bible calls hope.

2. How does Proverbs 23:7 relate to imagination and healing?

As a man thinks in his heart, so is he. By imagining your healing, you are thinking about it, and it will manifest.

3. Why do you think some people rely on other people's prayers for healing rather than getting a picture of their healing on the inside of themselves?

Possible answers: People are at different levels of spiritual maturity and some may have a low level of faith and need a stronger believer's prayer of faith; sometimes people are too lazy to do the work of meditating on scripture to get that picture of healing inside themselves.

4. If the Word of God is a seed, what should be done with that seed to produce healing?

Meditate on the seed and plant it in your heart. It will conceive and sprout, and you will see yourself healed on the inside. Once you see yourself healed on the inside, it is just a matter of time until it manifests in the physical realm.

5. How does Mark 11:24 relate to imagination and healing?

When you pray, you believe you've got the answer because of your imagination. It might be a short period of time until you see the manifestation, but it's in the future.
