1. How can you establish an atmosphere of faith as you minister?

You can establish an atmosphere of faith by teaching the Word of God. The Word of God is anointed, alive, and powerful and signs and wonders will follow.

2. Why is it important to remove distractions when trying to minister?

Jesus set the example of removing distractions. Distractions can cause unbelief or fear to manifest.

3. What does it mean to “take charge of the space” where you will minister?

When you take charge of the space, you are taking authority in the name of Jesus and dedicating it to be used for God’s glory. You are declaring worship and the presence of God where healing ministry will take place.

4. When ministering in a hospital setting, what are some things to be aware of?

Possible answers: In a hospital setting, be kind and represent Jesus well; don’t deny the facts but remember that God’s Word is truth and trumps any doctor’s report; going to a doctor isn’t a lack of faith, but always ask God first.

5. What are some practical technical pointers?

6. What are some considerations to keep in mind when you minister?

It is important to keep these considerations in mind while ministering: you are not a professional counselor; be careful about exchanging personal information; report any criminal activity, intent to commit suicide, or child abuse that is shared with you; ask permission to lay hands on someone; if someone falls under the influence of the Spirit, let someone else catch them; and rebuke demonic activity.
