1. What are some important aspects of the Gospel of the kingdom?

Possible answers: The Gospel has power and authority; it is Good News to the poor, deliverance, the healing of the brokenhearted, recovery of sight to the blind, and freedom from oppression; when the Gospel is preached, signs and wonders follow; the Gospel produces peace and faith in our life.

2. How do you know that healing is a part of the Gospel?

Possible answers: The New Testament clearly shows that Jesus had a healing ministry; the Greek word *soteria* means salvation, which includes deliverance and health.

3. Use Romans 10:14–16 to explain how people get healed and set free?

The steps to being healed and set free are to hear the Word of God, believe it, and obey the Gospel.

4. According to Luke 4, what did Jesus declare His ministry to be?

Jesus was anointed to proclaim the Good News to the poor, heal the brokenhearted, proclaim deliverance to the captives, give sight to the blind, and set the oppressed free.

5. What significant event happened in Jesus's life prior to Him delivering His message on what He was anointed by the Spirit to do (Luke 4)? How did He deal with the event?

Satan tempted Jesus in the wilderness when Jesus was weak and just before He announced His powerful ministry. Jesus refuted Satan's twisted truth with the truth of God's Word.

6. How can a person know if what they are hearing is the true Gospel?

Possible answers: They will feel peace, and faith will be stirred within them; there will be verses in the Word of God that will substantiate it; the true Gospel says that healing is for everyone and that Jesus offered it unconditionally.
