Note: All scriptures used in this lesson are quoted from the *King James Version*.

- I. Jesus provided healing for you in the Atonement just as much as He provided forgiveness of sins.

But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

Isaiah 53:5 KJV

- A. Jesus rebuked sickness because it is from the devil.

When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with his word, and healed all that were sick: That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses.

Matthew 8:16-17 KJV

- B. God does not want you to live in sickness. He has provided salvation for you, and salvation includes the forgiveness of your sins and healing.

Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.

1 Peter 2:24 KJV

- II. Jesus is the propitiation, the atoning sacrifice, for our sins.

And he is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world.

1 John 2:2 KJV

- A. The thing that gives you access to God's grace is not your goodness or your good works, but rather faith in what Jesus has done.

By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

Romans 5:2 KJV

- B. Jesus had already paid for your sins, so you just had to believe and receive. That's the same way that you receive healing.

As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk ye in him.

Colossians 2:6 KJV

- III. It's not a matter of getting God to stretch out His hand to heal, it's a matter of renewing your mind, believing, and releasing what has already been placed on the inside of you.

- A. Most people do not know what the Word of God says about healing.

So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Romans 10:17 KJV

- B. God no more chooses to heal some people and not others than He would choose to save some people and not others.

- IV. Forgiveness of sins and the healing of your body are promised in the exact same verse.

Bless the Lord, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his holy name. Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases.

Psalm 103:1-3 KJV

- A. The Greek word for "salvation" is *sozo*, which literally means to be whole, healed, and forgiven of sins.

Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord: And the prayer of faith

shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

James 5:14-15 KJV

- V. You've got to say, "This is mine. Jesus purchased this for me, and I am not going to let anyone steal this from me. I am becoming violent in this area of healing."

And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force.

Matthew 11:12 KJV

- A. Satan cannot do anything to you without your consent and cooperation.
- B. You cooperate with the devil when you think, Well, this is just normal. It's hereditary, and I can't do anything about it.
- C. You have to take your thoughts captive, and you have to be violently resolved: "I am going to have the healing that Jesus purchased for me!"
- VI. Jesus used a human relationship to illustrate how our heavenly Father treats us.

And I say unto you, Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you. For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

Luke 11:9-10 KJV

- VII. I believe that every sickness, every disease, every tumor, and every deformity that has ever come upon the human race entered into the body of Jesus on the cross.

As many were astonished at thee; his visage was so marred more than any man, and his form more than the sons of men.

Isaiah 52:14 KJV
