

POINTS TO PONDER

- Not only do you need to be listening to and careful of what words come out of your mouth, you also need to be listening to and careful of what words you're allowing into your mind.
- God has put His Word in your mouth, and when it's spoken out, you can use it against the lies of the enemy.
- Satan can't stop you from receiving the Word of God, but he will do everything in his power to distract you from putting it into practice, mixing it with faith, and bearing fruit in your life. He's terrified that you might just take the Word of God and believe it.
- The enemy is coming to steal the Word from you because he doesn't want it to become fruitful in you.
- Just like the world itself was created by the power of words, when words are spoken out of your mouth, they're powerful. You need to be careful what things are coming out of your mouth.
- If God has the blueprint for your life and you're broken, then He can fix what's broken.
- You need to be responsible for your words and understand that when you speak the Word of God out of your mouth, it's just as powerful to create or to destroy as if God Himself had said it.
- You need to be speaking the Word of God with boldness because its power is released when you speak. Roaring the Word of God and declaring everything in it over your life will cause situations to start to change.
- Faith is simply a trusting confidence in the Word of God, understanding what the Word of God says about your situation, and letting it be more real to you than your five senses.
- You can guarantee that your words have power, but sometimes they're having an effect in an area that cannot be seen by your natural eyes in that moment, so you take it by faith.
- We sow a seed of faith, and then we get a big shovel of unbelief and dig up the seed to see if it's growing. Then we wonder why it doesn't grow.

- “I’m not going to ask God to come and move a mountain that He’s already told me to move.”
- You can speak the Word of God with boldness.
- God wouldn’t have sent His Word and healed you if He didn’t want you to be well; He knows how powerful those words are.
- F.F. Bosworth put it this way, “Your success and usefulness in this world will be measured by your confession and your tenacity to hold fast to that confession.”
- “I’m not so worried about my speaking as I am about my believing; if I get my believing right, my speaking’s going to follow.”
- God needs your cooperation to speak out and to speak to the mountains that are in your life.
