

POINTS TO PONDER

- Many churches today have chosen the easy path of a seeker-sensitive type model of service where, rather than allow the Holy Spirit to move, they just boil everything down to the lowest common denominator of what will not cause any problems.
- We're not supposed to be following signs and wonders; signs and wonders are supposed to be following us as we preach and minister the Word. We're a supernatural people. God adds His super to our natural.
- If we will be available to walk in the gifts of the Spirit, there will be divine appointments that will wake people up and cause them to come into the kingdom and be saved. Then they will be hungry for the Word of God.
- Kenneth Hagin said, "Healing is the dinner bell." Many times, it's the gifts of the Spirit that release the healing power of God.
- When you receive healing by the gifts of the Spirit, that's wonderful, but you can't stay healed by the gifts of the Spirit. You've got to get into the Word of God.
- How are we going to do the same works that Jesus did and operate in the same power that He did if we're ignorant of the gifts?
- When using the gifts, make sure it's going to bless others because you cannot bless those you're trying to impress. Don't use the gifts to try to impress somebody or prove that you're super spiritual.
- The Gift of Faith is like Clark Kent going into the phone booth and becoming Superman. This is not the same thing as faith that comes by hearing the Word.
- Sometimes the Lord assigns a particular gift of healing to a ministry and they will see many people healed in one or two specific kinds of healings.
