1. According to Deuteronomy 28:58–61, what are some reasons the Israelites were sick?

**The Israelites broke God’s laws and opened themselves up to plagues and infectious diseases. They were under the Old Covenant.**

2. What are some reasons Christians are sick today?

**Christians today may suffer sickness due to self-inflicted lifestyle choices, diet, stress, and fear.**

3. How does the Greek word *soterion* apply to healing?

**The Greek word *soterion* means salvation, which includes forgiveness of sins, health, and deliverance.**

4. Should sickness have dominion over our bodies? Why or why not?

**No. Grace gives us the authority to reign over sin and sickness in our lives.**

5. In Acts 5:16, what is noted about the people who were healed?

**The scripture says that all were healed, and Jesus wasn’t even physically present. There was grace for every single person to be healed.**

6. What do you learn about grace and healing from the woman with an issue of blood (Mark 5:24–34)?

**Possible answers: Jesus healed her because of her faith, and He didn’t question her about going to doctors first; she creatively sought her healing in a way she hadn’t heard or seen done before; she didn’t let the past failures of the doctors stop her from believing Jesus would heal her.**

7. Why is hearing God’s Word an important aspect of healing?

**Possible answers: The Word of God is the seed that carries God’s grace for healing; the Word of God is health to our flesh; we enter into grace by faith, and faith comes by hearing Him.**
