

## Q&A Session 2

So, with the book and all of the resources that you've been given, continue to meditate upon these scriptures and lessons. Go back and listen to these truths as often as you need to. They will continue to stir you up for your own healing journey, walking in divine health, and being used by God to minister to others.

1. How can I help someone who is believing for healing but hasn't experienced the manifestation? How do I help that person on their journey?
2. In James 5:14-15, it tells us to call for the elders of the church to anoint us with oil and pray, then the prayer of faith will heal the sick. Do we have to be anointed with oil by elders in order to be healed?
3. What if you don't have oil? Is it absolutely necessary to have oil to pray for someone?
4. Is it important to really hear the Holy Spirit about what you should do in each moment that you're ministering? Which is more important: to do what you're comfortable with or to say, "Holy Spirit, how do You want me to pray for them?"
5. For someone who has just observed fivefold ministries operating in the gifts of healing, how can I operate in these gifts? So, for someone who is just seeing it, and it's stirring up their heart, how do they start to activate and step into that?

6. Do we need to know the source of the sickness in order to pray effectively? How can we know the source of the sickness?
  
7. What if the sick person isn't saved? How do we pray for them? Can God still heal them if they're not saved?
  
8. Can you tell us some of the things that you have done within your families to train your children about healing?
