QUESTIONS**

1. The *American Heritage Dictionary* defines *atonement* as, “The reconciliation of God and humans brought about by the redemptive life and death of Jesus.” Do you agree or disagree that healing is part of the Atonement?
2. After Jesus healed Peter’s mother-in-law, and all of the others who were sick, what reason is stated in Matthew 8:17 for Jesus healing all of the people?
3. Compare the verb tenses used in Isaiah 53:5, “*With his stripes . . . [you] **are** healed,*” (emphasis added) and 1 Peter 2:24, “*by . . . [his] stripes . . . ye **were** healed*” (emphasis added). What can we learn from these verb tenses?
4. According to Psalm 103:1–3, what two components are linked together as part of salvation?
5. What bold statements can you make about your healing based on Matthew 11:12?
6. How does Luke 11:9–13 compare the love of an earthly father with the love of your heavenly Father?
7. Most people think they do not have a choice about hereditary sickness and disease. What response might you give to someone who believes they have no choice?
