

## POINTS TO PONDER

- A seed carries within it the potential for infinite increase and multiplication. All of that is packaged in the seed. The seed is programmed to reproduce according to its nature. The seed is the Word of God. We were born again by the incorruptible seed of God's Word, and everything that salvation implies was packaged in the seed of God's Word. It found the soil of your heart and you agreed, believed, and confessed with your mouth—this is how the kingdom works.
- Everything is based upon seed, time, and harvest, and every word from God is a seed that is looking for the good soil of your heart.
- The more Word you receive, the more you will produce wholeness in your life.
- If healing has been packaged into a promise, that's a seed that's looking for the good soil of your heart. It will reproduce according to its kind, and you should have an expectation based upon the nature of that promise, the nature of that seed.
- Salvation includes physical healing. It's the same seed. It carries the same nature of God. So, let's not divide and keep some of the blessing of salvation off on one side; it's all part of the same seed of God's Word.
- Your healing is closer than you may have thought. It's in the Gospel that you have believed and confessed with your mouth, but perhaps lack of knowledge has kept you from understanding that seed was there.
- The same redemptive work—that same all-inclusive, spirit, soul, and body redemption that took place on the cross—includes the provision for physical healing. We've got to understand that when we're hearing the Gospel, we're sowing a seed that contains everything we need—spirit, soul and body. Healing is a part of the package.
- We are either cooperating with the finished work of Christ, with the flesh, or with the devil. As we walk through life, we're either going to cooperate with the seed of God's Word, the finished work of Christ, or we're going to cooperate with our flesh and the symptoms.
- If you're not happy with the harvest, change the seed.
- We get to choose. We're sowing all the time in everything that we do. We sow by forgiving or not forgiving. We sow by walking in joy or in bitterness. We sow by being stingy or giving cheerfully. We sow by what we eat, whether that's garbage or good food. We sow with our attitudes and our expectations.

- Some harvests are a process and some harvests are immediate. Regardless, they still flow and function according to the principle of the seed. There is no difference; only the time element is different, even for miracles. Miracles are a result of seed, time, and harvest.
- Many times we're trying to get healing, but we're still unforgiving, bitter, cranky, mad, or whatever. So, we're trying to get healed without caring for the soil of our hearts.
- Don't wait on the manifestation; keep sowing. When you wait on the manifestation, you're waiting for your body to tell you whether you're healed or not. Let God's Word be the final word.
- Health is a harvest. Continually sow the Word of God into your heart. Don't let it depart from your eyes, from your ears, or from your heart. Keep it there because it will produce according to its nature. It will fulfill the purpose that God sent it to accomplish.
