1. What power does the enemy have?

**The enemy has been defeated and has no power unless we give it to him.**

2. What tactics does the enemy like to use?

**Possible answers: The enemy uses deception, lies, distortions, and accusations to gain access to you; he targets people who don't know the truth; when a person is tired and in fear, he will attack; he likes to cast doubt on God's character.**

3. Use 1 Peter 5:8 to describe the enemy and his plan.

**The enemy is like a roaring lion, and he wants to devour us.**

4. What are three ways you can resist the enemy?

**1. I can resist by being steadfast in the faith by knowing what I believe. 2. I can resist the enemy by submitting myself to God and all that He has provided for me in Christ. 3. I can resist the enemy through my communication.**

5. How can you submit yourself to God?

**Possible answers: I can submit myself to God by drawing near to Him and knowing what His Word says; I can humble myself in submission to Him and His will; I can draw my strength from my relationship with Him so that the joy of the Lord is my strength.**

6. Is resisting the enemy a one-time event and victory? Explain your answer.
