Why do you want to minister?

What holds you back from ministering to others? How can you get to a place where you start ministering?

Prayer Points

Use these prayer points to write and pray your own powerful prayer:

- Thank God for His love.
- Thank God that He qualifies you and calls you to minister.
- Praise God that His Word has all of the answers you need to minister effectively.
- Declare that God will use you to minister to others so they will be healed and set free.
- Praise God that you will see miracles and signs and wonders because you believe in God's power in you.
- Commit to ministering to others.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to guide you and give you the words to say.
- Thank God that you will minister in boldness in His name.
- Praise God for these ministry tips and ask that they be brought back to your memory as needed.

Action Steps

Prayerfully prepare yourself and visualize yourself ministering to others. Read through your checklist and memorize key verses that you want to boldly speak as you minister.
