Self-Examination Questions

At any time in your life, have you heard and believed that healing is not for today? After today's lesson, what do you believe?

Personalize Greg's Closing Prayer

Action Steps

- In your Healing University journal, draw a small tree with roots. Label the roots "sin," and on the branches, write the different sicknesses, pains, and diseases you have or are in your family history. Now take a red marker, and draw a cross over the entire tree, totally blocking out the sin and sickness to show that the Atonement blots out sin and sickness.
- Settle in your heart that the root of sickness is sin and Jesus paid for sin and its fruit, sickness. Examine your heart, and when you are ready, make the following declaration and don't waver from it:

I believe that Jesus bore and paid for sin and its fruit, sickness. I received forgiveness from sin, and so I also receive my healing. _____ (sign and date)

- Write your own answer to this question: *What is the connection between sin and sickness?*
