

POINTS TO PONDER

- Some of the most powerful healings that I've ever seen happened through believers who were new believers who didn't know what they didn't know. They acted on the Word of God with what they did know, and they saw powerful results.
- Don't let what you don't know keep you from doing what you do know.
- Your love and faith toward all the saints now is alive and well. You can live out of the overflow of the love of God and thrive instead of just survive and help others do the same.
- The love of God loves to obey the Word of God. Doing the Word isn't a chore, or a task, or a have-to, but it's a want-to. The doing flows out from the being.
- The people of Jesus's day had already experienced being put under a heavy yoke of religious bondage while trying to be free, before Jesus arrived on the scene. They themselves failed to do what they were telling everybody else to do. They were more interested in being seen, even though they were spiritually blind themselves. Instead of seeing God's worth and praising God, they were more interested in being praised themselves, and on and on. Let's just make sure in this generation, in our own hearts, that our motivation for ministering to others is coming from the love of God for that person and not from any other motivation.
- Jesus showed us what the love of God expressed to human need would look like. But He wants us to be moving in compassion and being led by the Holy Ghost as well.
- Let that compassion, that love of God, be expressed through you to human need and watch the supernatural manifest every time.
- If you have a situation that comes up in your life where sickness is trying to attack your body and you're in a Bible-believing church, you can be healed. You can call for the elders of the church and have them come over and anoint you with oil. And the prayer of faith, from those elders, will cause you to rise up and be healed.
- We are commanded in 1 Corinthians 12:31 to earnestly desire the best gifts. The best gift is the one that you need when you need it. You don't have to worry about whether a gift will show up or not. No, the Holy Spirit will do His job.
- The Holy Spirit loves helping us and has given us everything we need. He is our very present help in times of need, in times of trouble. He's our present-tense help.

- There are many ways to minister to others. God has not made this hard. I love that about the Lord. The main thing is to activate what God has shown you. Don't wait for the perfect time. This is your appointed time.
- As you minister, locate where their faith is. Listen to what their heart is saying. Jesus met people where their faith was. And that's the most important thing to do as a prayer minister. Don't try to overpower or conquer someone if they aren't in the same place of faith that you are.
- You may need to interrupt people as their faith is giving their medical history. If you need to, do it in a way that doesn't put them down or make them feel inferior. Just say, "Listen, can I interrupt you just for a minute? What can we start with right now? I can see that you have a lot going on, but what can we start with right now that you can believe God for?"
- God doesn't see sickness in categories like we do. We see small sicknesses, medium-sized sicknesses, and really big sicknesses. In God's heart, all of them have already been healed.
- Learn to spot fear. Fear is humanly natural, but it is the enemy of faith, and it's a terrible motivator for healing and health.
- People are in all kinds of different places, so don't assume they know the Word of God. This may all be brand new for them. They may be coming from an unchurched background, so never assume.
