

POINTS TO PONDER

- We are the ones who get to say “Yes and amen” to the love of God.
- Compassion is different from pity and sympathy. Praise God, Jesus didn’t feel pity or sympathy for us. He didn’t look from heaven and say, “Oh, Father, doesn’t Your heart ache? If they would just stop sinning.” He didn’t have any condemnation toward us.
- People had never seen the kinds of miracles that Jesus performed. They had never seen large crowds like the ones He drew. He let compassion and the love of God move Him to do mighty things. In the same way, this is why our relationship and intimacy with God is so beautiful and powerful. It activates these things inside of us and motivates us to take action.
- I’m constantly praying over my own life, “Lord, don’t let me get so focused on my itinerary that I don’t see your people. Don’t let me get so busy or selfish that I am not moved by the love of God to take opportunities that come along.”
- Start stepping out and interacting with people. When they start sharing, step out and be motivated by the love of God. Ask if you can share something amazing with them.
- Stop looking at yourself and your abilities. Agree with what God’s Word declares about you.
- Ask God to take you out of your comfort zone. Ask Him to bring you to a place where it is not about you. That has to be our prayer.
- In an intimate relationship with God, your understanding of the love of God will grow, and you will begin to have a revelation of the love of God. It’s not just knowing the Scriptures; it’s knowing these are your promises and that that’s God’s viewpoint of you.
- The fear of man restrains us, but the love of Christ compels and moves us. If we value what people think of us, then we’ll never step out with this powerful movement of God’s love.
- I would rather step out in obedience and see signs and wonders and miracles in perfect strangers than always have other strangers think well of me.
- The love or the fear of man is a snare that can hold you back and keep you from speaking the life of God.

- The love of God changes your ability and your perspective. When you see the lost and sick, you will know what God's heart is for them. It will stir you; it moves you.
- I wanted signs and wonders to prove to everybody what a great missionary I was. However, that is a trap because then you do things for a show, and eventually your show will have no results.
- Show them how much God loves them, because if a person can realize how much they're loved by God, then they will believe that anything's possible. This is why the enemy tries so hard to destroy and deceive people about the true nature of God.
- Faith will be stirred up because it works through love and through understanding that God wants the best for us. God wants to prosper us, and sickness is not part of the prosperity of God's love.
- When you minister God's heart and desire toward people to reveal and show Himself and His love to them, when you become a spokesperson and an example of God's love and it overflows from your life, it will touch and change others' lives.
