

POINTS TO PONDER

- Jesus has already felt this for my child, and He has already taken care of it. I'm going to link up my child to my faith and say, "Lord, I just thank You for what You've done."
- If I go into a super-protective, I've-got-to-do-this mode, I'm going to do it wrong. So, I have to surrender my children to the Lord and say, "Lord, what do I need to prepare them for? I know You love them more than I do."
- When we minister to children, we have to get God's heart for them. Just as God loves us, God loves them. We don't have to take all of the burden on ourselves to heal them, protect them, and produce miracles in their lives. He loves them more than we do.
- Ministering to children is so rewarding. A child can come up, untainted by some of the doubts, unbelief, life experiences, and difficulties that you and I as adults have experienced.
- How are you going to be with the children in your life? You can say to them, "God has something great for you. God has something so good for you. Let me tell you God's Word over you. This is what this means. This is how God sees you. This is who you are."
- Don't think that they have no faith, no power, and no Spirit. In the same way, don't speak so spiritually to them that they don't understand what you're saying.
- I can make strong declarations because it's not about me. It's about God and His Word, God and what He did on the cross, and God and the victory of the cross that has overcome everything in the world.
- You can confess divine healing and life over your children.
- When I lay on my hands, I'm agreeing with and declaring God's Word, God's love, and His healing power.
- When ministering, I say, "Okay, I'm going to lay my hands on you, but I'm going to teach you something really powerful right now. You have Jesus inside of you. You have power in your hands. You have power in your heart to believe God, so I want you to put your hand on it too, and we're going to pray together. Not just me. You have Jesus inside of you, so we're going to tell this to go, in Jesus' name."
- As parents, you can get so busy that when a symptom comes, you just give a cough drop, and think, *Oh well*. Take authority right away: "I rebuke these pains. No, sickness cannot come on me. Colds are not part of our family culture. We will not receive it. No sickness can come in these walls."

- Healing is for everyone, at any age. God has enabled you; you have the Spirit of God inside of you.
