1. How do seed, time, and harvest work in a person's life?

Everything, in both the natural and the supernatural, functions according to the law of seed, time, and harvest. Everything in our lives is a harvest of seeds sown by us or by others.

2. According to Romans 10:17 and Luke 17:6, where does the seed of faith for healing come from, and how does it grow?

Faith comes for healing in the same way it comes for salvation—by hearing the Word of God. The seed of God's Word and His promises must be sown into our hearts. Then the seeds of faith must be spoken for faith to grow.

3. What is the incorruptible seed talked about in 1 Peter 1:23?
