1. According to Acts 1:8, what was the power the apostles were told to wait for?

Just before Jesus ascended, He told them to wait for the power of the Holy Spirit to come upon them.

2. How is the Holy Spirit involved in salvation and the baptism of the Holy Spirit?

When a person is saved, the Holy Spirit is involved by convicting the person of sin. When a believer receives the baptism of the Holy Spirit, the Holy Spirit comes and fills the believer with power.

3. Why is being filled with the Holy Spirit vital for believers?

Possible answers: The Holy Spirit gives revelation knowledge to help guide a believer into truth; the Holy Spirit brings power and authority to help believers resist the devil.

4. What is significant to note about when the Holy Spirit descended in the form of a dove on Jesus, and how does that relate to you?

5. Explain the process of receiving the baptism of the Holy Spirit.

A believer who has already received salvation simply asks and invites the Holy Spirit to come in and dwell in them. The Holy Spirit doesn't automatically come; He needs to be invited to take control of your life.

6. Why do you think more spirit-filled people don't speak or pray in tongues?

Possible answers: Some people were brought up believing it is from the devil; many people rely on their own understanding and are afraid; many churches don't operate in the gifts of the Spirit.

7. What might happen if all believers were filled with the Holy Spirit and prayed in tongues on a regular basis?
