LESSON REVIEW ANSWERS

1. Why is it important for believers to understand they have authority?

Possible answer: If believers don't know their authority, they will submit to lies and sicknesses that they have power to rebuke; when believers know and use their authority, they can change the world.

2. Use Genesis 1 and Genesis 3 to explain how God-given authority changed hands.

Genesis 1 explains that God gave mankind authority. Genesis 3 explains that Adam and Eve's sin transferred that authority to Satan.

3. How did Satan lose authority?

Satan lost authority when Jesus won it back for us through His death on the cross and His resurrection.

4. What does the Great Commission have to do with believers today and healing (Matt. 28:19–20, Mark 16:15–18, Luke 24:46–49, and John 21:16–18)?

Possible answer: Jesus won back all authority and gave it to His followers to use against the enemy and to go into all of the world and make disciples. We use that authority in all areas of our lives, including health. We can go make disciples and lay hands on the sick and they will recover.

5. How can believers use their authority to make disciples?

Possible answers: Believers can help people understand what lies the enemy has told them and rebuke the lies so the people can see God's love for them; believers can use their authority to do signs and wonders to show God's power.

6. According to 1 Peter 5:8–9, is Satan powerful enough to devour you?

No; Satan cannot devour me as long as I understand my authority and use it to rebuke him. Satan is like a roaring lion looking to devour, but I have authority to stop him and not fall for his lies.

7. What are some examples of taking your authority over sickness, such as during flu season?
