

POINTS TO PONDER

- According to Luke 4:21, the Gospel is fulfilled in our hearing. This is super important because many times, people have heard a Gospel that doesn't have any power.
- We need to make sure that what we're listening to is *really* the Gospel. And one way to tell if it's the Gospel is if it has power and authority. The true Gospel changes lives.
- There is power in the Word of God when it is preached. So, if the Word of God isn't being preached in truth, there's not going to be any power accompanying it.
- The Gospel has power in it, and it stirs up faith in the hearers.
- If you're not leaving church different from how you went into it, then maybe you haven't heard the Gospel.
- When the Gospel is preached, healing follows. It cannot be separated.
- The fact is that the Gospel contains healing, prosperity, deliverance, freedom, safety, favor, and friendship.
- The Gospel delivers, heals, and saves us. That's how we know the Gospel is being preached. The Gospel is for everyone, and that means that the power of God is for everyone.
- Some people start attaching rules and regulations to determine whether God is going to heal or not. It changes how people view who God is and what He has done or will do for them. That's a twisted Gospel.
- We need to get back to the pure, unadulterated Word of God—the uncut version of the Gospel that has power. We need to say, "I'm going to cast aside my preconceived ideas about what I think the Gospel is. I'm going to read the Word of God, and I'm going to believe every single word, whether I feel like it or not."
- I've heard the Gospel, I've heard the Good News, and I'm trusting in the Word. Faith comes by hearing. We have to respond to the Gospel.
- Jesus never told anyone to learn to live with sickness.
- You have the same power and authority as Jesus, and the same trick that the Enemy tried to play on Jesus, he's trying to play on you. He's trying to tell you that you're poor, weak, sick, and defeated and that there's nothing you can do about it. Remember that the same power that raised Jesus from the dead lives in you. Start to recognize the Enemy's lies, because, you've now heard the Gospel.
