1. What is important to remember when your heart wishes you could take the child's pain or sickness?

Jesus already bore the pain and sickness for the child. Jesus had that same heartache for you and for your children. Use that heartache to motivate you to be Jesus's hands and voice ministering to that child.

2. Why is it important to remember that God is a Father?

As a Father, He loves children more than you. He wants them to be healed and to be living abundantly.

3. Why shouldn't you look down on a child?

When a child receives Jesus at salvation, they receive the same Holy Spirit as an adult, and Jesus the Healer lives inside of them.

4. What are some healing declarations you could make to a child in a way the child could understand?
